## Modern Marriage <br> By <br> Uncle Paul's Quilting Company

## Fabric Requirements:

$61 / 2$ yd - Fabric A - Background - While/Light Green Batik
$11 / 2$ yd - Fabric B - Large "Focus" Square - Blue Floral Batik $11 / 4$ yd - Fabric C - Large Tile Square - Blue/Green Batik
$1 / 2$ yd - Fabric D - Medium Tile Square - Aqua Batik
$1 / 4$ yd - Fabric E - Small Tile Square - Navy Blue Batik
$1 / 3$ yd - Fabtric G - Corner Tile Square - Light Green Batik $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - Binding

This quilt is ideal for using scraps and smaller pieces of fabric. Check cutting requirement for needed "squares" of fabric if you wish to create a scrappy version.

## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A - Cut 2-25 $1 / 2$ " strips, sub-cut into $2-25 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 25$
$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut $10-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sub-cut into 2 $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{\prime \prime}$ strips, $6-25 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, 2 $-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 15 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, $6-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, and $6-51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares; Cut 14-4 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips; Cut $3-31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sub-cut into $2-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, $2-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and $6-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
Fabrics B - Cut 2-25 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric C - Cut 3-10 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ " strips, sub-cut into $10-10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10$ $1 / 2$ " squares
Fabric D - Cut 2-5 $1 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sub-cut into $10-51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric E - Cut 1 - $31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sub-cut into $10-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2$ " squares.
Fabric F-Cut 1-9 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, sub-cut into 2 - $91 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

## Construction:

1. Using $2-25 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares of Fabric $B, 2-251 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 151 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-25 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of Fabric A, create two of the following units. Press seams toward Fabric A.

2. Using the $10-101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric $C$ and $6-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles of Fabric A, create two of each of the following units: Press Seams toward Fabric C

3. Using the $10-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares of Fabric $D$ and 6 $-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles of Fabric A, create two of each of the following units: Press Seams toward Fabric C

4. Using the $10-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric $E$ and $6-$ $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles of Fabric A, create two of each of the following units: Press Seams toward Fabric C.

5. Using the $2-91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric $F$ and $2-$ $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of Fabric A, create two of each of the following units: Press Seams toward Fabric F.

6. Using the $2-3 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ and $2-5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of Fabric $A$ and the units created in steps 5 and 4 , create two of the following units. Press all seams toward Fabric A.

7. Using the $2-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 15 \frac{1}{2}$ " and $2-5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 25 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangles of Fabric $A$ and the units created in steps 3 and 6 , create two of the following units. Press all seams toward Fabric A.

8. Using the $2-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 25 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles of Fabric $A$ and the units created in steps 2 and 7 , create two of the following units. Press all seams toward Fabric A.

9. Using $2-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips of Fabric $A$ and the units from Step 1 and Step 8, create 2 of the following units, pressing seams toward Fabric A

10. Join all remaining $41 / 2$ " strips of Fabric $A$ together to create a single strip.
11. Measure the length (long measurement) of the quilt through the center. Cut three $41 / 2$ " strips to this size. Join the pieced section with the three strips. Press seams toward Fabric $A$.
12. Measure the length of the quilt through the center cut 2-4 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of Fabric A. Attach the strips to either side of the quilt. Press seams toward Fabric A.
13. Top is now ready to layer with back \& batting, quilt and bind.
